Although our life is more difficult this year, as James lost his fight with cancer, he always said when the going gets tough, the tough get going - to a TOGA party! So get ready for the annual James Ragan Triumph Scramble and TOGA Party. This year marks 2 milestones for us. Not only has TOKC completed its first project of raising 1.5 million dollars to fund research through our Children's Sarcoma Initiative (with those funds having been matched by M.D. Anderson Children's Cancer Hospital), but also, this May would have marked James' 21st birthday. James' vision was a world without children's cancer, and I and the rest of the TOKC board members, now more than ever, are determined to make that vision a reality. As James always loved new beginnings, it is fitting that TOKC is embarking on a new project to make his vision a reality. The most promising step in cancer research in recent years has been whole genome sequencing for adult cancers. As with other types of research, little work has been done in whole genome sequencing for pediatric orphan cancers due to the cost. Yet genome sequencing is essential to providing the knowledge and understanding necessary for researchers to learn how to cure pediatric cancers. For that reason, TOKC is pleased to announce the start of The Childhood Genomic Research And Sequencing Project, which will provide longitudinal whole genome sequencing for childhood cancers. This is an ambitious project, but it holds the most promise for the future. As with the Children's Sarcoma Initiative, which we will still fund, and due to the importance of this work in solving the problem of pediatric cancer, the first 1.5 million dollars for this project will go to M.D. Anderson which has agreed to match it dollar for dollar.

The Childhood Genomic Research And Sequencing Project - because the key to curing pediatric cancer is within our GRASP.
 We feel weaker this year with James passing. He was always our Wingman, and we were always his. The issue of wings was always special to James because his thoracic surgeon had a unique method of making the incision so that the curved surgical scars across the back brought wings to mind. His pediatric patients always referred to them as "Angel's Wings." To help us remember James each year, we are starting the "Wingman" program. Each year we will have a special pediatric cancer patient as our guest so we can always remember James and the reason we Golf and Toga each year.

Finally, James was the honorary starter at each of the prior Triumph Scrambles. This year, in his absence, the honorary starter will be past Burke Cup Champion, current U.S. Amateur Champion, future U.T. Longhorn golfer and long time close friend of James, Scotty Scheffler.

So please join us again in memory of James for the 8th Annual Toga Party and 7th Annual Triumph Scramble Golf Tournament. As James always believed, together, we will someday Triumph Over Kid Cancer.

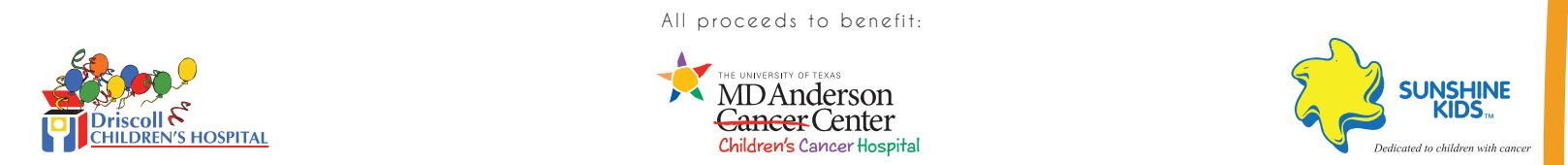
