Transfer to Kingsbarns for tee off at 10h00 - everyone's favourite - the most popular course in Scotland to be played twice....

FORMAT: The format of the event is an Individual Stableford over 72 holes incorporating Turnberry, Royal Troon, Carnoustie, and North Berwick. A second Individual Stableford leg will take place on St. Andrews Castle Course, both rounds on Kingsbarns plus everyone's dream – St Andrews Old. The reason for 2 rounds on Kingsbarns is because everyone asks for it each year!

COSTS/PAYMENT: R 68,990 per golfer sharing (an increase of only R2,500 on 2012 rates), R43,734 per non-golfer sharing; Single: R87,954 per golfer. Deposits of R35,000 per golfer and R20,000 per non-golfer have to be prepaid by 10th December 2012 and the balance, excluding airfares to follow by 28 February 2013. This is in order to secure these courses and the hotels, most of which demand full prepayment upfront. In addition, in order for me to secure St. Andrews Old, rather than have to go into the ballot, the deposit above is an absolute pre-requisite. A lot of time and effort has gone into preplanning this tour and luckily I am allocated each year firm spots on St Andrews Old. I can only take 24 players and priority will be given to those who have already

committed, and the balance will be treated on a first come first serve basis. An event like this has to be organised and booked a year in advance which I am sure you will appreciate.

Rates are subject to fluctuation at time of full and final payment and airfare issue. The conversion rate of 13.5 (to the Pound) has been used as an estimate as all quotes are in pounds. I am obviously unable to control this so any additional amount due because of fluctuation has to be paid at the end of February.

You are also entitled to use Voyager miles or arrange your own airfares in which case the airfare costs will be deducted accordingly. Airfares and taxes are approx. R11,200 which amount is included in the above costs. Please note however that we are subject to airport tax & fuel fluctuation up to time of issue which is only 3 months prior to departure. British Airways are the chosen carrier – in the past few years since the operation of Terminal 5 no baggage or golf bags have been lost.
