

1. How much do we pay?

R1000. This is 10 monthly events at R100 each.

2. How many people can we have in a syndicate?

The formation of the syndicate is up to the members of that particular group. It could be two, three, four, five, ten people. The school will recognise the syndicate as one member and there must be one membership fee paid (R1000). The name of the syndicate could be indicated on the application form with the name of a contact person.

3. How often is the draw?

Once a month, excluding December and January. First draw on 27 June.

4. How many prizes are there?

100 Club winner – R1000 (not an attendance prize); an attendance prize winner - R500; a joker draw – half the pot (a possible winner); at the first draw there will be an early bird winner which will be for the first 50 members to have paid their full R1000 – a R1000 prize. These amounts may be revised, but not downwards.
